

# Laka Lodge

**O**n the Island of Perfumes of Comoros, the three-star Moheli Laka Lodge is a beach resort set amidst the magnificent National Marine Park of Moheli in Nioumachoua on the fabled Comoros Islands. Situated in the north of the Mozambique Channel, between Madagascar and the East African Coast, Moheli is the smallest island of the Comoros Archipelago, also named the Archipelago of the Moon Islands.

You can relax and enjoy your stay in one of our 15 double rooms, of which ten are grouped two by two in separate bungalows, two spacious studios, a villa with a two-room apartment and a

large panoramic suite, each with a separate terrace and a fully equipped bathroom. All rooms are within steps from the beach and enjoy beautiful ocean views. The rooms are a short walk to the restaurant, which serves healthy and fresh local dishes, and the "Whale Bar" which sits atop the peninsula provides panoramic views of the lagoon and the isles.

Our kitchen offers a fine cuisine of mainly local products and ingredients based on local and international recipes, with many products that come straight from what the sea daily offers. Experience our wonderful fish, shrimps and wild camarons,

mangrove crab and lobster, grilled or à la vanille, tropical oysters and calamari, fresh fruits and vegetables and accompanied with plantain bananas, manioc and bread fruit to mention just some of the delectable fare on offer.

The entire zone of the Marine Park of Moheli is now protected including the coral reefs with its giant sea turtles, the dugong, and you can come to swim in total safety with different kinds of dolphins, manta rays, humpback whales and pilot whales and snorkel the many coral reefs surrounding the isles. Each year about 1,000 whales visit the waters of Moheli migrating from the



Antarctic. In the beginning of the Antarctic winter around April they start their long 6,000km journey through the Mozambique Channel reaching Moheli in July and staying with us until early November.

At Laka Lodge we go that extra mile to ensure your holiday is an unforgettable experience. For divers there are only few places left in the world waiting to be discovered. The Marine Park of Moheli spans over 400km<sup>2</sup> of coral reef and sand banks. Laka Lodge Diving invites you to be one of the first to experience a unique dive.

During your stay you can choose from many eco-tourism activities: whale watching with our sea

worthy boat, snorkeling on the sublime coral reefs, play beach volley, ping-pong, badminton, tour the lagoon with one of our canoes or kayaks or traditional "Laka". You could choose to go fishing or hiking in the coastal and primary rain forest, make a trip by bike or foot to the traditional villages around, or by car to the Giant Sea Turtle Reserve or the Livingstone Bats Reserve or simply enjoying your time on one of our private beaches and swim in the ever pleasantly warm Indian Ocean.

Moheli Laka Lodge lies on a peninsula that offers three spectacular sun drenched beaches dotted with thatched umbrellas.

The seawater has a perfect temperature all year round and you can swim in complete safety protected by the coral reefs while snorkeling your way around in the most exceptional natural aquarium.
